

Community Media Center of Marin Internship Program

As a CMCM intern, you will gain experience in a nonprofit TV station setting and learn how PEG (Public, Education, and Government) Access Stations work for the community. Please note that this is mainly a production internship, but it will entail working in an office setting doing a wide range of tasks, which will include some administrative responsibilities.

The internship will provide training in studio production, field camera production, Final Cut Pro editing, and equipment maintenance. Main responsibilities include crewing on studio shows, assisting members with questions, assisting with equipment maintenance, special projects and some administrative tasks on an as need basis.

Requirements

Basic familiarity with video production highly preferred. Internship candidates with a strong commitment to community media and a demonstrated willingness to learn technical production techniques will be considered. Candidates must be able to work and collaborate with a diverse membership.

Internship Terms and Time Commitment

- Spring Interns: January-June 15th (5 month commitment)
- Summer Interns: June-September 15th (3 months)
- Fall Interns: September-January 15th (4 months)

Interns can work two weeknight shifts (5pm-9pm) for a total of 8 hours a week OR a Saturday shift (Noon-6pm) for a total of 6 hours a week.

Students

Academic credit is available upon request, but internship not limited to students.

Internship Benefits

As an intern, you will have free access to our production equipment and post-production facilities, even if you are not a Marin County resident. CMCM provides workshops, which you will have free access to during your internship in Studio Production, Field Production, Non-Linear Editing (Final Cut Pro) and more. After successful completion of the internship program, interns receive an additional six months of free membership and access to the facilities and equipment.
